Re: FuelEd Online Credit Recovery Registration

Dear Parent, or Guardian(s):

According to school records, your child has been identified for having failed one or more classes at Pueblo West High. Any student that has failed one or more of their core subjects during the 2018-2019 school year will need to “recover” that credit for graduation. If your student has not made up the needed coursework, the FuelEd Online Credit Recovery program will give them the opportunity to do so.

In order to make up the failed course(s), we will be offering credit-recovery opportunities June 4 - June 27. The cost is \$100 per .5 credit (semester credit). **All classes must be completed by June 27th to receive credit** and will be taken using the FuelEd Online curriculum offered through Pueblo School District 70.

School laptops will **NOT** be available for summer school courses. Students will use Pueblo West High School’s computer labs to complete work during summer-school lab hours on **Tuesday and Wednesday mornings** from 8:00 am to 12:00pm, and **Thursday afternoons** from 3:00 to 6:00pm. It is strongly recommended that students attend these sessions in order to stay on track for finishing on time. Students will also need to have access to a computer outside of these hours in order to finish in a timely manner. It is suggested that students access the community library, if needed, for this reason. Any test that needs to be completed can **only** be administered at Pueblo West High School during the lab hours.

Student registration will be held in the auditorium lobby at PWHS on Thursday, May 30th from 2:00pm-6:00pm and Friday, May 31st, from 8:00am-12:00pm. If you have not previously taken an FuelEd online class, students must attend the orientation at 8:00AM on June 4th, the first day of class. **Advisement of credit recovery by the counseling department will be completed prior to your registration.**

Parents, by working together we can collectively help your child maintain their academic focus and keep them on track for their anticipated graduation from high school. Questions pertaining to the classes which we recommend for credit “recovery” should be directed to the counselors at Pueblo West High School.
